Raizer guarantees a safe and stable lift




- Can be operated by one person

- Ensures an ergonomically correct lift, avoiding overexertion of your back and arms.




- Can be controlled both remotely, allowing you to work in your optimal working posture, or by using a button on the seat.

Minimal manual handling




- → Easy to transport using trolley or two bags.
